Traffic Tolerant Alfalfa with Improved APH 2 Resistance

A-100 Grazer is a high yielding Alfalfa variety with sunken crowns that was bred to handle extra wheel traffic from Star Seed's breeding partner. This alfalfa variety has an excellent agronomic package that includes resistance to Aphanomyces Race 2 which provides a very persistent and healthy plant for high production over a broad range of soils.
